This is a special MCC meeting. There will be no video coverage.





#### The MCC

The Midcoast Community Council is an elected Municipal Advisory Council to the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors, serving the citizens of the unincorporated Midcoast in Miramar, El Granada, Princeton, Moss Beach, and Montara. The Midcoast Community Council is comprised of seven members locally elected to four year terms. The Council currently holds regular meetings at 7:30 PM on the second and fourth Wednesdays of each month (except November and December) at the Seton Coastside Medical Center in Moss Beach. ### History

The MCC was established in May of 1991 by Resolution 55042 passed by the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors. Summary history of the formation of the MCC.

#### **Bylaws**

The Bylaws are the operating procedures of the MCC. The original Midcoast Community Council Bylaws were typewritten, with amendments taped in. Those bylaws have been scanned, OCR'd, and hand-corrected. There may still be some scan/OCR errors remaining, which will be corrected when found. The last update was May 13, 2007. San Mateo County Council is currently reviewing an updated format of this version of the Bylaws.
