Thank you for sending this referral to the Midcoast Community Council for Caltrans refurbishing of SR1 between the southern boundary of Half Moon Bay and Marine St in Moss Beach.

In the Midcoast, this project appears to consist mainly of resurfacing the roadway and replacing inadequate infrastructure, including poles, culverts and other things.

We have reviewed the extensive material on environmental protections, traffic control and construction limitations and trust they will be followed.

We have the following questions and comments:

The photographic material of the Surfer's Beach area does not adequately portray the serious degradation to the roadway and encroaching erosion in that area.

We would appreciate a more careful analysis of this portion of the roadway, along with plans for keeping it open long-term.

This is a lengthy and large project. Extra effort will need to be made to inform the community of what to expect and plans for emergencies added into traffic control plans.

Plans state this will need to be repeated in 20 years and that a 40-year plan was rejected. Given that this is an extensive project on a vital artery, anything that would prolong the life of this roadway restoration is worth considering. Finally, can you explain the purpose of the CCTV installations?

It is possible that the MCC will have further comments but we want to adhere to your deadline as much as we can, so are sending this now.
