## **Desirable Traits in a Coastside Design Review Committee Member:**

- 1. Must have a good sense of design, color, proportion, beauty, and an affinity for our natural surroundings.
- 2. Must have some professional, academic or hobby experience with architecture, graphics, design, planning, or the arts.
- 3. Preferably a resident of the Coast for several years in order to recognize the subtleties of "community character" in our various communities.
- 4. Must be able to visualize proposed projects, changes, and alternatives.
- 5. Must be able to deal with a fair degree of stress.
- 6. Must be able to interpret the CDRC Guidelines with unbiased community sensitivity.
- 7. Must be able to understand the balance between individual "rights" and community sensibilities.
- 8. Must be able to communicate in a friendly, courteous, and agreeable manner.
- 9. Should have a goal to build community as well as apply the design guidelines to presented projects.
- 10. Must have the traits of a mediator to creatively find compromise solutions for neighborhood and County design concerns.
